Who is eligible to participate?


- Candidates must reside in Fort McMurray

- Must pass pre-employment drug and alcohol testing

As a Welding Apprentice you will learn how to:

- Read and interpret blueprints and determine weld process specifications and requirements
- Operate manual, semi-automatic welding and flame-cutting equipment
- Rebuild and repair worn out parts
- Work safely and efficiently as a team key member in a busy welding, machining, and fabrication shop

As a Machinist Apprentice you will learn how to:

- Read and interpret blueprints, drawings, and engineering information to fabricate products and one-of parts
- Operate machine tools and equipment such as: Conventional and Computer Numerical Control (CNC) type mills, lathes, surface grinders, radial drills and Horizontal Boring Mill
- Rebuild and repair worn out parts
- Work with clients to produce intricate parts and equipment



FAQ's

- Q) What is the recruitment process for this position?**
A) If you are selected, there will be an interview and pre-employment testing.
- Q) Will there be an opportunity to see the designated work environment?**
A) In-person shop tours/info sessions will be scheduled for December and in early 2024.
- Q) Do I need to have my driver's licence?**
A) A driver's license is not required but will be considered an asset.
- Q) What type of experience do I need to be considered?**
A) You do not need previous experience to be considered for an apprenticeship position. We ask you to bring a great attitude, be safety aware, and we will teach you the rest!
