In very important news, ACFN has been working diligently to address the concerns surrounding the water contamination at Big Dock in Fort Chipewyan. After learning that Transport Canada conducted tests in 2017 and never informed us of the results, we conducted further testing that has confirmed contamination of the waterfront. We are deeply disappointed and disturbed that our community was not informed by the Federal government in 2017 of these results, and we have arranged for Nunee Health to offer health screenings, and we are working with Athabasca Tribal Council to provide healing circles. We will continue to ferociously investigate and advocate for our Members and Nation to hold Canada to account for their failure on this very serious issue with tremendous impact on our people.

As always, we are honoured and grateful to serve as your Chief and Council. As we head into this season we want to wish you all a Happy Thanksgiving. This is a season for reflection and gratitude, and as we count our blessings we want to express our appreciation for all ACFN Members and the support you have shown us. We look forward to seeing you at one of our upcoming events!


