


Q1 How familiar are you with the Treaty Annuity Settlement?



Q2 How long have you been a registered member of ACFN?



Q3 Before becoming a registered member, how connected were you to the Nation?



Q4 Are you a resident of Fort Chipewyan?



Q5 If you live or lived in Fort Chipewyan, how long have you or did you live there?



Q6 The Treaty Annuity Settlement is intended to address Canada’s failure to adjust annuity payments over time. What does this settlement mean to you personally? (Select one)



Q7 How important is it to you that this settlement provides benefits for both current and future generations?



Q8 How would you like to receive your portion of the settlement funds?





Q10 . Should parents/guardians receive their child’s per capita distribution on their behalf?



Q11 At what age should minors receive their per capita distribution?



Q12 Should minors have access to financial literacy resources before receiving their distribution?



Q13 If a portion of the settlement funds were placed in a trust, one option could be to use it for community programs such as housing, education, and economic development. How do you feel about this approach?



Q14 If a portion of the settlement were placed in a trust, which areas should be prioritized? (Select your top 3 choices)







Q17 Some Nations that received full payouts in the past spent the funds quickly, leaving little or nothing as long-term support for members. How important is it to you that we avoid this outcome?


