ACFN INTRODUCES NEW MOBILE APP

We are excited to announce the launch of a new mobile app for ACFN Members!

ACFN has worked with Hawk Solutions, which was created by Nautsa mawt Tribal Council, a non-profit society supporting ten

Coast Salish Nations, and a technology provider specializing in secure, customized solutions, to customize and app for ACFN Members. This app has been designed by First Nations for First Nations!



Below you will find the steps to download the app and connect with ACFN in an entirely new way!



- Install the Hawk Communications app from your Google Play Store (Android) or App Store (Apple).
- Launch the app and choose your permission settings. You will then be directed to the login page. Click the Request Account button.
- You will be directed to a page to fill out your basic personal information. Fill out all required fields and under My Account Request select "Athabasca Chipewyan First Nation". Click Submit.
- 4. After your account request has been approved by the admin, you will receive an email notification that your account has been approved. Click the link in the email to activate your account. Make sure to check your spam and junk folders for an email from "noreply@einsignt.net"
- Start exploring the app!
