## **Greetings from Chief and Council - Continued**


### **Stay Safe and Enjoy the Season**

Complete applications must be received before these dates to be considered.



#### Key Parts of a WILL:

- Executor Manages your estate
   Beneficiaries This is the person who inherits your assets (things).
   Guardians Caregivers for minor children
- Specific Gifts Property, money, or items you wish to give.
