First Nations!


The new app provides easy access to information on resources, events, updates and alerts for Members, as well as an emergency management function that can be quickly deployed in emergency situations.

Below you will find the steps to download the app and connect with ACFN in an entirely new way!

HOW TO INSTALL ACFN MOBILE APP

- Install the Hawk Communications app from your Google Play Store (Android) or App Store (Apple).
- Launch the app and choose your permission settings. You will then be directed to the login page. Click the Request Account button.
- You will be directed to a page to fill out your basic personal information. Fill out all required fields and under My Account Request select "Alhabasca Chipewyan First Nation". Click Submit.
- After your account request has been approved by the admin, you will receive an email notification that your account has been approved. Click the link in the email to activate your account. Make sure to check your spam and junk folders for an email from "noren'o" learningtant.net".
