DETAILS:

- 5 days on/2 days off Mon-Fri, 7.5-hours daily, and 37.5 hours per week. Candidates must have their own accommodation and transportation. These temporary student roles are expected to end on or before **August 31, 2026**. Rotating roles and cross-training experience are provided.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- **Administrative Assistant, Fort McMurray:** To assist with ACFN/DLRM events, Dene Days, virtual and in-person events, planning multiple events; Assist with corporate sponsorship and fundraising.
