DETAILS:

- 5 days on/2 days off Mon-Fri, 7.5-hours daily, and 37.5 hours per week with ACFN Housing Department, and Uncle Fred's Youth & Elders Lodge.
- These roles are local to **Fort Chipewyan, AB** - Candidates must have their own accommodation and transportation. This temporary student role is expected to end on or before **August 31, 2026**.

GENERAL DUTIES:

- Labour outdoor work: Yard work, example: mowing, trimming, planting, raking, etc.
- Minor construction work, i.e., clean-up, painting, sanding, etc.
- CSA steel toe boots and PPE are provided.
- Other duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be First Nations or Inuit secondary and post-secondary students aged 15 to 30 years old.
- Must be a current full-time registered high school or post-secondary student and returning full-time for the fall semester.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.

- Willingness to learn; and to work in a diverse team environment
