The K'ai Tailé Market (KTM) is seeking to fill one (1) part-time **Janitor** position; for up to **Fifteen (15) hours a week**; Monday to Friday; 3 hour days; and have a willingness to work variable shifts including evenings, weekends, and holidays. The schedule may change from time to time to meet operational requirements. The role reports to the Co-Manager and is responsible for cleaning and sanitizing the KTM premises. This is a local position to **Fort Chipewyan, AB**. Candidates are responsible for their own accommodation and transportation.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Keeps building and property in a clean and orderly condition.
- Performs cleaning and sanitizing duties by:
 - Sweeps, mops, scrubs, or vacuums floors.
 - Gather and empty trash.
 - Scrubs, sanitizes, and replenish restroom facilities.
 - Dust furniture, walls, and equipment; cleans and polish fixtures and furniture.
 - Cleans windows, mirrors, and partitions with soap and other cleansers.
- Follows procedures for the use of chemical cleansers and power machinery to prevent damage to floors and fixtures.
- Shampoos or steam-cleans carpets and rugs.
- Manages inventory of cleaning supplies
- Notifies supervisor regarding the need for repairs or supplies.
- Ensure the practices of safety regulations.
- Responsible for maintenance, cleanliness, safety and sanitation of the equipment, preparation room and store.
- Other duties as required.

JOB QUALIFICATIONS:

- High School Diploma or equivalent or a combination of Education (Grade 10), training and experience may be considered as an alternative to a High School Diploma.
- M.S.D.S., and WHMIS (Workplace Hazardous Material System); training may be provided.
- Microsoft computer skills (MSWord, Excel and Outlook).
- Thorough understanding of Health and Safety legislation, policies, and practices.
- Strong organizational skills.
- Must be punctual, reliable and dependable.
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs.
