- Assist children with communication, social interaction, emotional regulation, behaviour, and daily routines.
- Use positive behaviour support strategies and proactive approaches to encourage appropriate behaviour.
- Support children during classroom activities, outdoor play, meals, transitions, toileting, and other daily routines.
- Implement visual schedules, sensory supports, communication tools, and other accommodations.
- Help create and maintain individualized support plans in collaboration with families and professionals.
- Observe and document children's progress, behaviour, developmental needs, and successful strategies.
